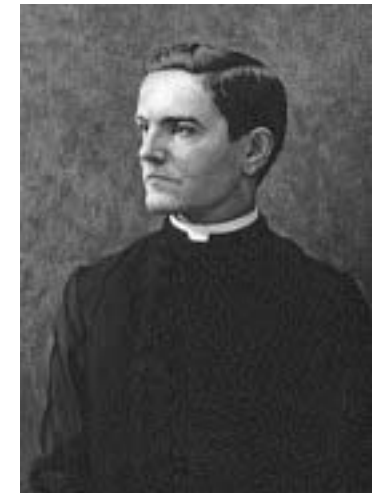

WHO ARE WE? We are a Catholic men's fraternal organization founded in 1882 by Fr. Michael McGivney.

HOW MANY MEMBERS? There are approximately 200 men of all ages in our growing St. Leo council.
