

On Spirit, One Vision, One Community Campaign Update

Since the launch of the One Spirit, One Vision, One Community Campaign in September 2017, we reflect with deep gratitude on the steadfast commitment of our generous communities. As we begin our third fiscal year of the campaign, we are pleased to announce that out of the \$4.5 million pledged, we have received over \$2.3 million directed to the goals set by St. Pius X, St. Leo the Great, and St. Pius X / St. Leo School. We look forward to moving into the final stages of this campaign with a sense of great accomplishment and renewed visions.

Across all three communities, we continue to accomplish many of our goals while experiencing and sharing in the success of this campaign in many ways. Here is an update of projects funded by the One Vision Campaign since July 2018:

St. Pius X Parish completed many follow up repairs after the completion of the new roof last year and continued to make payments toward the original church construction loan.

St. Pius X / St. Leo School was able to add to the tuition assistance and the teacher compensation trust fund and added the roles of Assistant Principal and Dean of School to the administration staff.

St. Leo the Great completed the roof replacement for the entire campus and upgraded the air conditioning system in the fireplace room. Funds are still being collected for the new youth center and adoration chapel.
